### **FOGGING FOR MOSQUITOES TO BE CONDUCTED WEDNESDAY NIGHT ALONG THE CONTRA COSTA COUNTY WATERFRONT**

**WHAT/WHY:** Due to high numbers of adult mosquitoes being detected and associated elevated risk of West Nile Virus in the county and surrounding areas, the Contra Costa Mosquito & Vector Control District will be fogging by truck to control adult mosquitoes.

**WHEN:** Wednesday, September 27. Fogging will take place between dusk (approx. 8:00 PM) and midnight, weather permitting.

**WHERE:** The area bordered by Hwy 1 - 680 on the west, Waterfront Rd on the south, Pacheco Slough on the east and the shoreline of Suisun Bay to the North.

**TREATMENT:** will be made with truck-mounted ultra-low-volume equipment using [Pyrenone 25-5 Public Health Insecticide](#) (pyrethrin) applied at a rate of .75 oz/ acre.

**ACTION REQUIRED BY RESIDENTS:** None. All products used are approved by the Environmental Protection Agency for the use of controlling mosquitoes and protecting public health.
